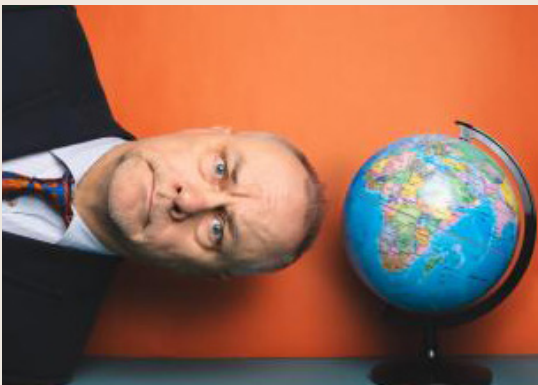
## Eastbourne 2025

01 November

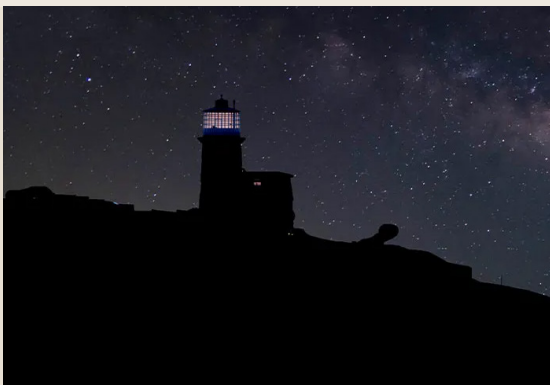
