
'WHAT'S ON' EASTBOURNE 2024

Eastbourne Half Marathon 3rd March 24

Eastbourne's seafront Western Lawns plays host to the south coast's food and drink festival for a three day extravaganza to tantalise the taste buds. You'll be able to sample around 100 real ales, ciders and perries along with some great entertainment from live bands on the festival stage throughout the weekend.

Eastbourne Carnival - 25th May 24

The biggest Seafront Carnival in the South East will return this year. More than 1,500 walkers are expected to take part with some 25,000 fans and supporters. The Carnival will be from Fisherman's Green to the Wish Tower Slopes starting at 2pm.

UK Ultra - 26th May 24

A 100km point to point trail race from Arundel to Eastbourne. Starting in the picturesque town of Arundel in the shadows of the magnificent Arundel Castle the race passes through the South Downs National Park and some of the most beautiful countryside the UK has to offer.
